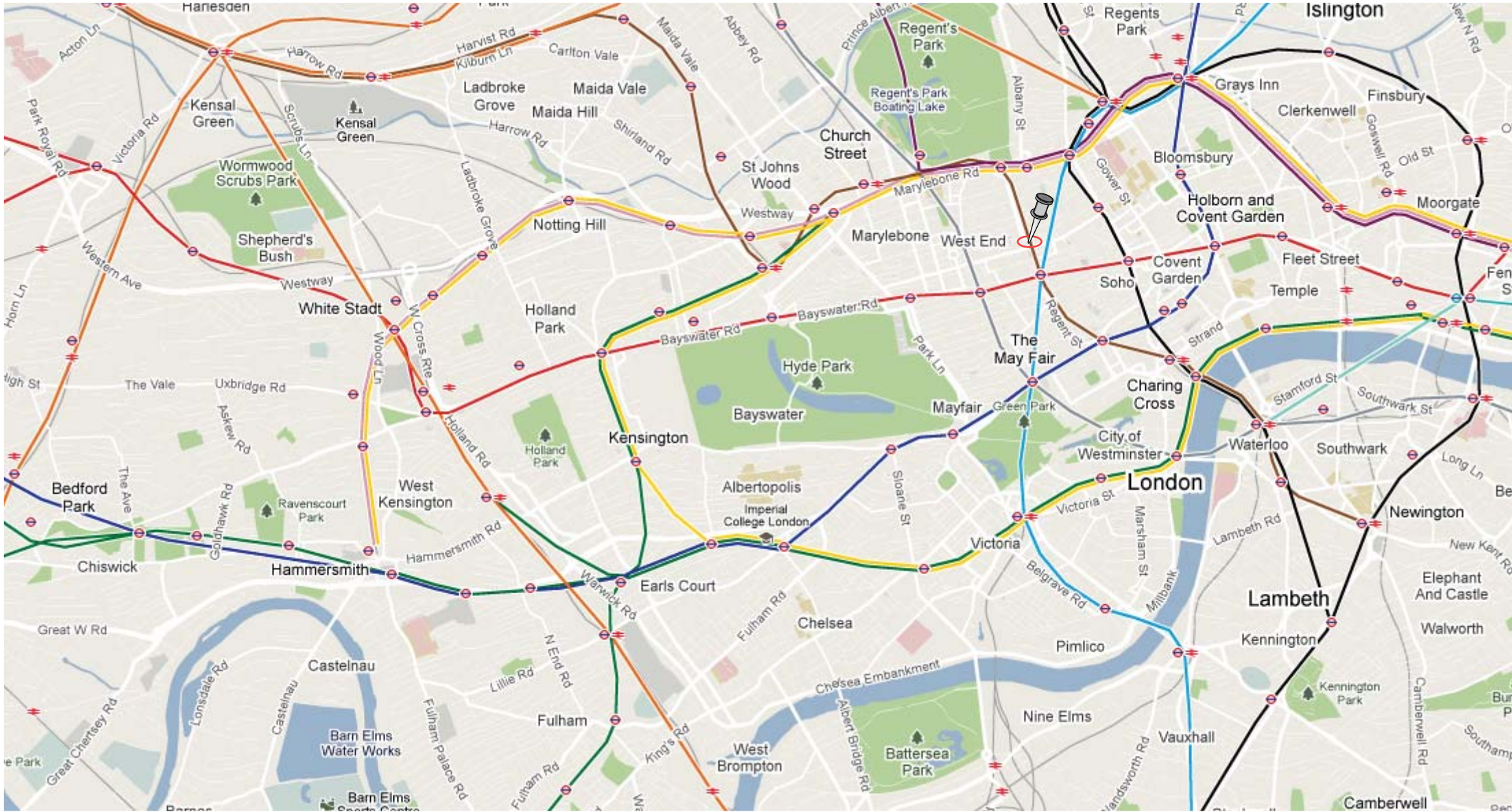
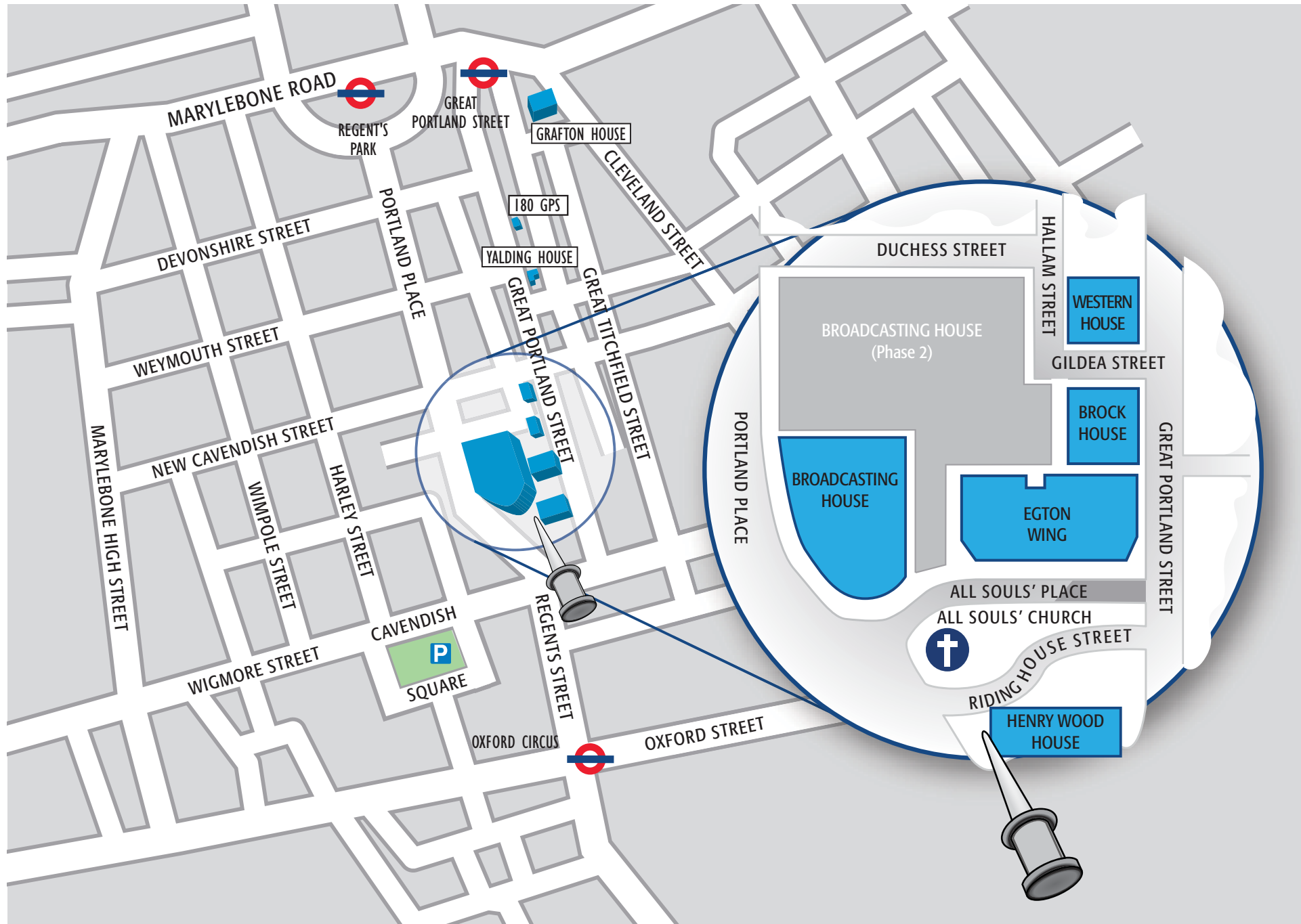


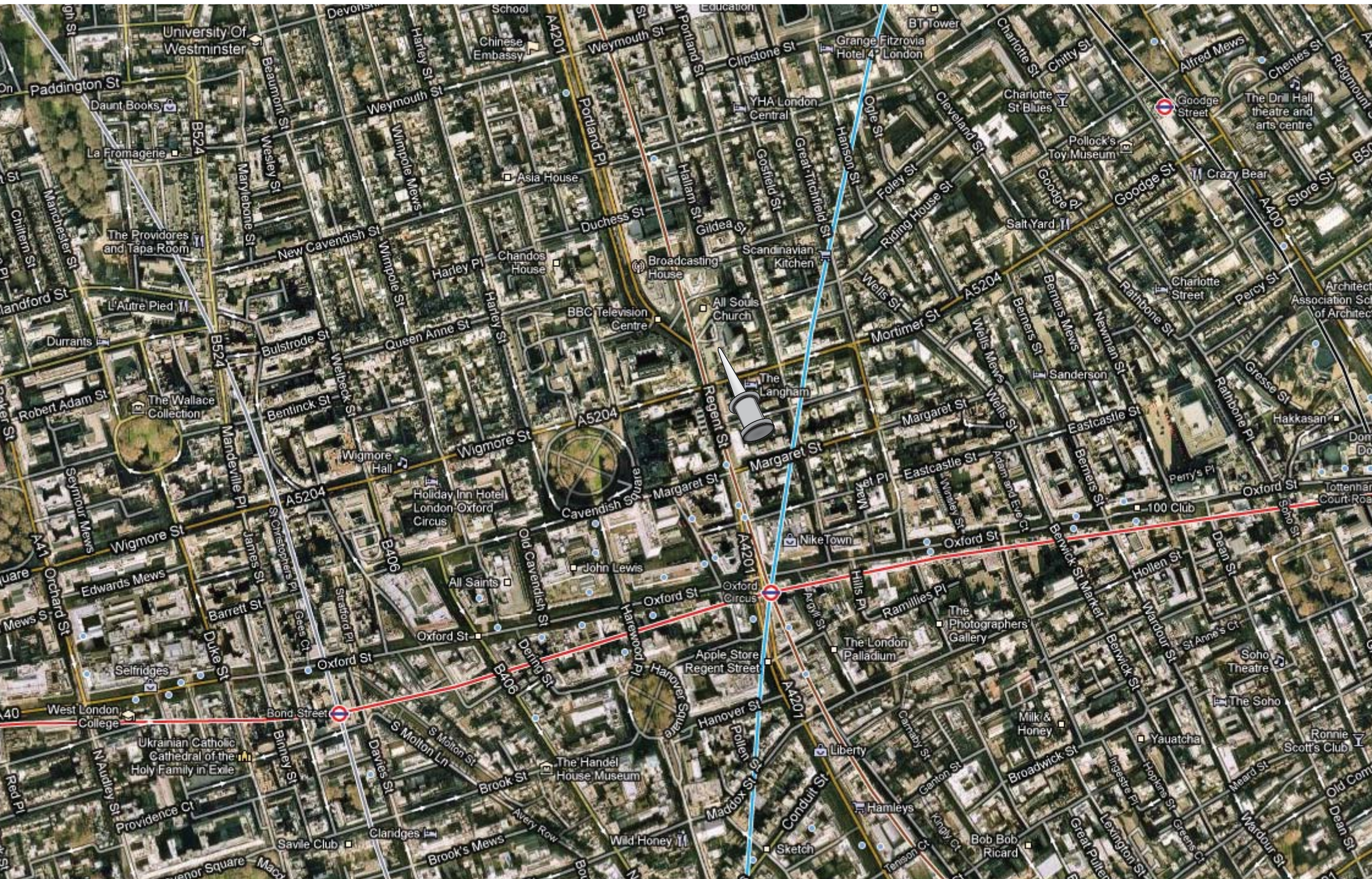

Standing in Oxford Circus looking North - note the cranes and a church spire in the distance. Walk north towards this church. Marked with a red circle

When reaching the Church you'll see Broadcasting House (ornate stone building on the left) - All Souls Church (the church) and then next to Pizza Express at the rear of it - is the entrance to Henry Wood House - Marked with a red circle.,



### ***Rail*** (Main Line - if coming from outside London)

Paddington Station is nearby - connects with Underground: Bakerloo Line (see below)

Euston Station is nearby - connects with Underground: Victoria Line and others (see below)

Liverpool Street - connects with Underground: Central Line and others (see below)

Victoria Station - connects with Underground: Victoria Line and others (see below)

### ***Underground***

Nearest station:

Oxford Circus - on Central Line (Red), Victoria Line (Light Blue) and Bakerloo Line (Brown)

Alternative:

Regents' Park - Bakerloo Line (Brown)

Great Portland Street - Hammersmith & City Line (Pink), Circle (Yellow) and Metropolitan (Purple)

Google Maps also shows underground lines if you turn on the public transport layer.

### ***Buses***

A wealth of buses stop nearby - as it's one of the central hubs.

## *Airports*

From London Heathrow - get the Hethrow Express to London Paddington (about £15 single), then get on the Bakerloo Line (Brown) going to southbound - get off at Oxford Circus and walk from there. (couple of minutes - you come out of station at Oxford Circus - walk north up Regents Street towards a church with a large spire sitting in the middle of the road. See photo below for bearings to Henry Wood House reception.

From Stanstead - get the Stanstead Express to Liverpool Street, change to the Central Line (Red) going to White City (or Acton, or Ealing Broadway, or West Ruislip - they all go the same way for your needs) and get off at the Oxford Circus station and walk from there (walking directions as above)

From Gatwick - get the Gatwick Express to Victoria station, change to the Victoria Line (Light Blue) northbound to Oxford Circus - get off and walk from there (see walking directions above)

Luton is a bit more difficult - there is a shuttle bus to the nearest rail station called 'Luton Airport Parkway' from there you can get a train to St Pancras - then you should be able to get a Circle line (Yellow) train towards Hammersmith (Westbound) and you get off at Great Portland Street - follow map for directions.
